



## HOPE VALLEY FARMS SWIM & RACQUET CLUB

- **Membership cards must be presented to the staff.**
- Members must sign in and register any guest prior to entering the pool.
- Membership cards are not allowed to be loaned or given to anyone for use. Management reserves the right to terminate membership for misuse of membership cards
- Guest fees are \$5.00 for all guests located within 30 miles of HVF. A ten punch guest pass may be purchased from the clubhouse for \$35.00. These passes are valid for the 2006 pool season only.
- Guest fees are \$10.00 on all special event days such as Opening Day and July 4th.
- Guest punch passes cannot be used on special event days.
- No one individual may be a guest at the pool more than **four times** each summer.
- There will be no charge for guests who live more than 30 miles away.
- Children under the age of 6 must be closely supervised by an accompanying adult
- **Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or person over 14 years of age**
- Children using flotation devices must be accompanied by a parent or guardian
- Children under 1 year may be accompanied by a parent with direct contact during adult swim. Children over 1 year old must sit out during adult swim.
- Adult Swim is for persons 16 years or older
- Please shower before entering the pool
- Persons with skin disorders may be denied use of the pool
- No Band-Aid allowed in the pool
- Proper bathing suits are required. No cut off shorts, thongs, workout or tennis clothes allowed
- No smoking anywhere on club property
- No chewing gum allowed in the pool deck area
- No pets allowed on the pool deck or near the locker rooms
- There is to be **NO GLASS** on the pool deck. This means you will need to transfer your baby food, drinks, etc. into plastic ware. If glass breaks on the deck we have to drain the whole pool !
- No food or drink allowed in the pool
- **No Running on the pool deck**
- **No Diving**
- No profanity, intoxication, improper or vulgar behavior is accepted
- Break- Will be called at the beginning of every hour for 10 minutes beginning when the pool is clear of all children under the age of 16.
- **Furniture-The pool furniture has been placed around the pool to comply with the Health Department Rules of Clearance for swimming pools. Please do not move the furniture.**
- **Diaper changing-Changing diapers on the pool deck is not permitted. Do not use the pool deck as part of the diaper changing process.**
- Radio-You are welcome to bring radios for your private enjoyment. However, for the comfort of others members, we request that headphones or ear pieces be used.
- Hard Balls- Are not permitted in the pool area.
- Rough Play- For the safety of others rough play/ horse play will not be permitted.
- Water guns-Due to the dangers of running in the pool area, waterguns are not allowed on the pool deck.
- Pool floats - Are permitted at the pool as long as it is not crowded. The lifeguards will have the final decision on whether or not floats are permitted.
- Safety Ropes-Please stay off safety ropes and/or lane lines.
- Lap lanes- Are for continuous swimming only. No playing or cutting through the lap lanes
- Starting Blocks- Are not for general recreational use.
- Kickboards- They are for use as swimming aids and/or swim instruction only
- Basketball-No hanging on the rim or net.
- Basketball-Play may be suspended during heavy pool use
- **Trash—Please clean up your table/area before leaving so other members may enjoy the pool**
- **The pool will close for 30 minutes each time thunder or lightning is heard or seen**
